The Department of Public Works would like to thank you for your patience over the last few weeks during the much needed drainage work in Lynchville Park. We were very pleased to get a much earlier than anticipated start this construction season. Let's hope Mother Nature continues to smile on us.

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that while we had planned to start reclaiming, grading and paving next week, there has been an unanticipated update on the Manchester Water Works project to bring water into Lynchville and Danis Park.

The town was successful in obtaining American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to install water mains throughout the neighborhood. What this means is it would not be prudent at this time for us to install brand new pavement for them to come in over the next few months and start digging it up for their pipe work. Unfortunately, this will require even more of your patience as our trench patches will only be temporary until the Manchester Water Works project is completed and we can return to finish our portion of the work.
