- Building Board of Appeals (meets as needed to hear Building Code appeals)
- Cable Television Community Access Committee (meets the first Monday of the month)
- Conservation Commission (meets the fourth Wednesday of the month)
- Goffstown Common Oversight Committee (quarterly meetings)
- Historic District Commission (meets first Thursday of the month)
- Library Trustees (meets the third Wednesday of the month)
- Planning Board (meets the second and fourth Thursday of the month)
- Solid Waste Commission (meets every other month, third Wednesday)
- Zoning Board of Adjustment (meets the first Tuesday of the month)
- Piscataquog River Local Advisory Council
- Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission
